Dr. Sara Humphreys has been an Assistant Teaching Professor at the University of Victoria since 2017. She has served on Senate (2020) as well as a variety of committees and working groups, including the Senate Committee on Curriculum, Indigenous STEM Retention and Access working group, the Faculty Association Teaching Committee, among several others. Sara was the Faculty Mentor for Online Learning in the Humanities for 2020-2021, Course Coordinator for ATWP135 Academic Reading and Writing (which enrolls nearly 2 000 students a year) and is currently the acting director for the Academic and Technical Writing Program (2022-2023). Prior to her position at the University of Victoria, she served as the Vice President of the Trent University Faculty Association and as a Member-at-Large for the St. Jerome's University Faculty Association executive committee. At both institutions, she was a member-at-large on Senate. She is active in her field, with a monograph published by the University of Nebraska Press in 2021. She has a strong belief in the interconnectedness of teaching, research, and service.
