Nomination Form

The Nomination Form must be signed by no fewer than three persons who are eligible to vote in the election and signed by the candidate that they are willing to stand for election.

Candidates are to submit a brief biographical sketch and statement of candidacy (not to exceed 300 words). This material will be made available on the University Secretary's website and on the WebVote ballot.

The nomination form along with the biographical sketch and statement of candidacy are not valid unless they are received in at usec@uvic.ca not later than 4:30pm on Wednesday, March 15, 2023.

Eligibility

Persons eligible to stand for election, to make nominations and to vote shall be regular faculty members. The Senate, using the definition in the *University Act*, has specified that "faculty member" is a person who is classified in University records as "faculty" and designated as "regular, at the rank of lecturer, assistant teaching professor, teaching professor, assistant professor, associate professor or professor, or in an equivalent position designated by the Senate". (This includes faculty members at the rank of "associate teaching professor", and excludes employees classified as "visiting", "adjunct", or "sessional".)

The Senate has further determined that a faculty member on leave of absence or study leave from the University of Victoria continues to be eligible to vote and to hold office on the Senate and the Board of Governors subject to the rules of those bodies.

Withdrawal

Withdrawal by a person duly nominated as a candidate for election shall be made in writing to the University Secretary (see Rules to Govern Elections to the Board of Governors and the Senate, section 8.1).

Term of Office

The term of office for this position on Senate will begin on July 1, 2023 and will end on June 30, 2025.
