## 4. **REMARKS FROM THE CHAIR**

## a. President's Report

Prof. Cassels provided a report to Senate. He reported on upcoming meetings in Ottawa with newly elected federal MPs and members of Cabinet. He also updated members of Senate on a recent visit with Ministry of Advanced Education Assistant Deputy Minister, Fazil Mihlar. Prof. Cassels commented on a recent meeting of the Vancouver Island post-secondary institutions' presidents.

Prof. Cassels reported on the appointment of a new Registrar, and on upcoming recommendations for approval of the Strategic Research Plan and the updated Campus Plan. He also referenced the work being done on an internationalization plan and an Indigenous Academic Plan.

## 6. PROPOSALS AND REPORTS FROM SENATE COMMITTEES

#### a. Senate Committee on Admission, Re-registration and Transfer

#### i. Revised calendar entries relating to failure to disclose

Dr. Ken Stewart, Chair, Senate Committee on Admission, Re-registration and Transfer introduced the proposal.

A comment was made that the requirement for students to disclose all studies had the potential to be onerous. In a situation where a mature student had taken a variety of courses over a number of years at several institutions, it could be difficult to obtain transcripts for, or even recall, all courses taken. Dr. Stewart responded that the rationale for requiring all courses to be disclosed was that it should not be at the student's discretion to decide what is appropriate to disclose. For completeness of the record and in order to ensure that the maximum number of transfer credits are applied, it was noted that all courses must be declared.

In response to a question regarding how students would be aware of the policy, Dr. Stewart provided some information on the application process.

A comment was made about the punitive nature of the regulations. It was noted that students might unintentionally fail to disclose a course, and a question was raised regarding how this would be addressed. Dr. Stewart responded that there was flexibility in whether and what penalties were imposed. A comment was made that the regulations did not signal an intent to support students and it was suggested that something to this effect be included.

A challenge for international students in obtaining records was observed.

A question was raised regarding whether there could be some mechanism by which students could obtain advice about what previous studies were relevant to disclose during the application process.

<u>Motion:</u> (J. Aragon/L. Francis Pelton) That Senate approve the attached revisions to the academic calendar regarding failure to disclose studies elsewhere, effective May 1, 2016.

A question was raised about the number of academic units required to qualify for renewable scholarships. Ms. Lori Nolt provided information about the requirements, as well as about flexibility in place to accommodate students with disabilities.

A further question was raised about the policy or practice of imposing limits on scholarship amounts offered to students. Ms. Nolt responded that limits could be imposed but that no specific threshold was in place. There was some discussion regarding how this policy was communicated and why it may not be appropriate to have a university-wide limit.
