As we enter into the last phase of our UVic SEM planning process, we would like to invite you to an information session focused on reviewing and seeking your feedback on the tactics and implementation plans that will be included in our SEM plan. Throughout the process of developing our Plan, we have held several consultation sessions for the UVic campus community and the feedback we have received has been integral to the success of this project. As this will be our last information and feedback session before the plan is finalized, we are hoping that many of you will be able to participate.

The event will begin at 1:00 pm with a very brief overview of the SEM process to date and an introduction of the recommended goals, strategies and tactics. At 1:30 pm, attendees will be able to walk through each room to review the 15-20 action plans associated with SEM Goal assigned to that room. Each SEM Goal (1 through 6) will be assigned a different room in Cadboro Commons. Members of the SEM committees and our consultants will be in each room to answer your questions.

Recognizing that you will not be able to provide feedback on all of the implementation plans, you may find it helpful to review the goals, strategies and tactics in advance and participate in the sessions that are of greatest interest or most relevant to your work. The goals, strategies and tactics document will be circulated to registrants in late-November.



We will be requesting feedback on four areas:

1. Do you believe that the tactics listed will allow the strategy to be implemented?
2. Are we missing anyone in the supporting/collaborating table?
3. Do the action steps represent the critical steps required in order for the tactic to be realized?
4. Do the timelines/resource requirements indicated seem reasonable?

We acknowledge that this is a busy time on campus, so we will offer additional methods for providing feedback on the implementation plans.
